Clinical trial phase 1 study

Clinical trial phase 1 usually involves health human subjects. It is performed to ensure the quality, efficiency, and safety of the new drug.



What is involved in being a volunteer?

Before you are eligible to take part in a clinical trial, you will be given all the trial information by a member of our recruitment team and will be invited to attend a full medical screening by one of our Unit doctors. Upon the results of this medical and receipt of your medical history from your general practitioner you may then be invited to participate in the trial. You will also be required to stay in the clinical facility for some time period (usually 24-36 hours) depending on the study requirements.

Is it safe?

The safety and well-being of all volunteers at our unit is the primary concern of the clinical staff, all of whom are highly trained professionals in their field of expertise.

What is the importance of a volunteer?

Healthy volunteers and patients play an essential part in the development of new drugs, treatments, assessing products and helping to test new and existing medicines to combat disease. By taking part in a clinical trial, you will receive inconvenience fee for your time and inconvenience.
