Sharmini Selvarajah is an Associate Professor of Epidemiology (Clinical) at the Department of Social and Preventive Medicine, University of Malaya and a Research Fellow at the Julius Center, University Medical Center Utrecht, the Netherlands. Prior to this, she served as a Clinical Epidemiologist with Clinical Research Centre, Ministry of Health Malaysia. She obtained an MBBS and a Masters in Public Health from the University of Malaya, before completing her PhD in Utrecht, the Netherlands, through a scholarship funded by the European Commission.

Sharmini Selvarajah's clinical research topics include prognosis and therapeutic evaluations in cardiovascular disease (acute myocardial infarction) as well as preventive cardiology. She has (co)authored 13 papers, been an invited speaker at national cardiology conferences and is an ad hoc reviewer for international journals such as the BMC Cardiovascular Disorders and Diabetes Research and Clinical Practice.
