Overview

Most questionnaires were developed in English speaking countries. With the increase in the number of multinational and multicultural research project, the need to use and to adapt questionnaires has grown rapidly. The cross-cultural adaptation of health status self-administered questionnaire for use in new country, cultural and/or language necessitates use of a unique method, to reach equivalence between the original source and target versions of the questionnaire. The items must not only translated well linguistically, but should also be adapted culturally to maintain the content validity of the instrument at a conceptual level across different cultures. However, the dilemma faced by researchers in Malaysia is the availability of validated questionnaires. Without validated questionnaires, conclusions from these researches are questionable.
