GCP Overview

GCP is a standard for the design, conduct, performance, monitoring, auditing, recording, analysis, and reporting of clinical trials that provides assurance that the:

- Trial subjects' rights, integrity, and confidentiality are protected.
- Data and reported results are credible and accurate.

Malaysia has adopted GCP in 1999, and since then doctors are required to undergo training on GCP leading to certification prior to participation in clinical trial. This course is specifically designed to meet this requirement.

- To provide experience in the key skills required through simulation in classroom setting
- To provide some of the resources required to design and to conduct GCP trial
- To achieve an overall understanding on how to conduct GCP compliant clinical trial
